Policies & Enrollment Information Registration Information



- The Registration Fee is <u>\$150</u> due at time of registration. <u>\$50</u> for each additional sibling.
- A Supply Fee of \$150 per child will be invoiced to our families August 1st.
- Current accounts must be up to date in order to register your child for the upcoming year.
- Registration form must be filled out, returned to the director, and fees paid to hold your child's spot.
- Enrollment will be accepted in the order it is received and is limited for each age group.
- Registration is open to families of all denominations.
- At least one guardian <u>must</u> download the ProCare app on their phone. This is the preschool's main form of communication & invoicing. In an emergency, alerts will be sent out through the app.
- Our classrooms are a structured environment with a Learning Through Play philosophy.
- Children with <u>developmental delays or special needs</u> are required to meet with the director before
 registration to discuss and ensure that we can safely provide for their child on a day-to-day basis. A
 trial period will be put in place to assess the child's adjustment to preschool as well as our ability to
 meet their needs in a positive progression. IEP meetings with your child's therapist may be required if
 we deem them necessary.
- Children must be <u>up-to-date on their vaccinations</u> following what is required by the NC Department of Health and Human Services. *www.immunizenc.com*.

Tuition

- 2-Days a week (T/Th) annual tuition \$1.665 and invoiced \$185 per month Sept-May
- 3-Days a week (M/W/F) annual tuition \$2,025 and invoiced \$225 per month Sept-May

5-Days a week (M - F) - annual tuition \$3,150 and invoiced \$350 per month Sept-May

Tuition will be invoiced at the beginning of each month. If a child drops out, the full month's tuition is due. A 10% LATE FEE will be charged to all delinquent accounts by the 16th of each month. Accounts must be in good standing for your child to continue to attend Centenary Preschool. Please remember that we are a nonprofit preschool, our operation, including salaries, is affected by non-payment.

Early Risers

- Begins the second week of school (September 8th)
 - Begins at 8:05 Mon- Fri
 - Cost is \$5.00 per day
 - No carpool option for Early Risers
- Parents will be invoiced at the end of the month for any days your child attended.

<u>Arrival & Dismissal</u>

• Carpool will begin at <u>8:50 and continue until 9:00</u>. Any families arriving

after 9:00 must enter the building through the church office doors to drop off their preschooler.

• **Dismissal** will begin at <u>11:50 and no later than 12:00</u>. Families will enter the building through the church office doors and pick up their preschooler at the classroom doors.

Medical Policy

- To minimize the spread of contagious germs, please keep preschoolers home if they are running a fever, vomiting, or have diarrhea **OR** if anyone residing in your child's home is diagnosed with a contagious disease such as Flu, Covid, stomach bug, Strep, etc.
- If your child develops a fever of 100*F or higher while at preschool, you will be called to pick them up.
 - If your child has 2 diarrhea episodes while at preschool, you will be called to pick them up.
- We recognize that there are times when little ones may have runny noses due to allergies or teething, but if you suspect it may be something more than that, please err on the side of caution and keep them home.
 - Children returning to school after being sick should be free from fever, diarrhea, vomiting, etc. for
 24 hours without the assistance of medication.

Emergency Conditions

- When the Craven County Schools are closed due to weather-related or emergency conditions, we will also be closed. In the event of a 2-hour delay, we will open at 10:30am and dismiss at 12:30pm.
 - Centenary Preschool does not do make-up days.
 - Information and alerts will be sent out through our ProCare Parent App.

Please make sure all contact information in ProCare is up to date at all times
